

ADA COMPLIANCE KIT FOR SELF-STORAGE FACILITIES



ADA's scoping requirements call for 5% of the first 200 units and 2% of the units over 200 to be accessible.
-36 CFR Part 1191 Appendix B Section 225.3

ADA CLOSE DOOR HANDLE C-ADA-CL



Installation: Remove standard door rope from back of bottom bar handle. Feed the rope end of ADA close door handle through holes and secure with a knot.

ADA HANDICAP SYMBOL SIGN WITH BRAILLE. C-ADA-SB



Installation: Remove backing from adhesive squares and press into place at desired height.

ADA OPEN DOOR HANDLE C-ADA-OP



Installation: Drill hole in center of door (must be 15" to 48" above the floor). Install the ADA open door handle with included washer and nut. Secure the nut with vice grips while tightening with a screwdriver from the outside. Cover the nut on the interior



OUTDOOR RAMP

Installation: The ADA outdoor ramp is built to supplied measurements unique to each storage facility. The width of the opening and height of the rain lip must be submitted to DBCI for a custom ramp. Each ramp lays in the door opening and against the unit's rain lip.
